

The Traditional Way(s) of Getting Paid



Business accepts **check** for **clients stuck on the paper-writing bandwagon**



Business looks for a processor as clients push them to accept credit card



Client receives invoice, logs into bank, enters info, and sends **ACH** to **avoid writing a check**



Business decides to accept wire transfers because why not add another choice?



Manual processes and inefficient payment methods experienced by firms and their clients



The New Way Forward

Payment processing that is fully online <u>and</u> integrated



Auto-generate invoice from logged time and expense Send invoice with an easy-to-use payment link **Remind** client of payment due based on your set cadence Securely **collect**payment as
client chooses
ACH or credit
card

Avoid manual work by automating reconciliation to your accounting



4 Do's and Don'ts of Invoicing & Payments

Formatting!

- "Due upon receipt," Net 7, Net 14, Net 30, Net 45, Net 60, Net 90, etc.
- If offering an early payment discount, use a standard format such as "2/10 Net 30" for a 2% discount if paid within 10 days

2 Be polite!

- Include keywords in your invoice note, term description, or bottom of the invoice like "please" and "thank you"
- Studies have shown that taking the polite route can get you paid up to 2 days faster ¹

3 Include invoice terms on your contract <u>and</u> invoice!


- Life gets easier if your invoice terms are discussed before work begins
- Always outline invoice terms in your invoice

4 Include your preferred payment options!

If you want to get paid online, list "ACH" and "credit card" as preferred





